**ORDER APPROVING TRUSTEE'S APPLICATION FOR EMPLOYMENT
OF SHUMAKER, LOOP & KENDRICK, LLP AS SPECIAL COUNSEL (Doc. 93)

THIS CASE having come on for consideration without a hearing upon the Trustee's Application for Order Approving Employment of Shumaker, Loop & Kendrick, LLP as Special Counsel pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 327 and Rule 2014 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure Effective as of June 4, 2020 (Doc. 93) (the "Application") filed by Douglas N. Menchise, as Chapter 7 Trustee, and this Court having reviewed the Application; having noted that any objections to the Application were not timely filed or have been withdrawn; and being otherwise familiar with the papers and pleadings in this cause, accordingly, it is

ORDERED:

1. The Application is **APPROVED** effective June 4, 2020, as set forth herein.

2. Steven M. Berman and Shumaker, Loop & Kendrick, LLP (collectively “SLK”), are hereby authorized to serve as special counsel to the Trustee, for the purpose of representing the Trustee in connection with asset recovery as more particularly described in the Application.

3. The Trustee shall make no payment to SLK without first filing an Application for the allowance of such payment, and the subsequent entry of an Order approving same.

4. Further, compensation will be determined at a later date in accord with 11 U.S.C. §330.
