Dear Ms. Loesch:

Enclosed is a copy of the "REPORT AND NOTICE OF INTENTION TO SELL PROPERTY OF THE ESTATE" that I received recently. I am a creditor that was severely injured financially and emotionally by the actions of Procom America, LLC due to their insolvency.

Although the number of customers was listed as 2165, that number does not represent all of the people that were taken advantage of since in many cases only one person's name was listed when in fact that one person represented others in their family that are part of the same claim. For instance, my name is listed; however, both my husband and my daughter are part of the claim. Also, the amount listed by our names does not include the money that was paid to Procom America, LLC for insurance. And for your information Travelex Insurance underwritten by Berkshire Hathaway Specialty Insurance claims no liability due to the fact that Procom America, LLC solicited the insurance plan to its customers when in fact on the application it states that "BONUS COVERAGE" includes "Financial Default Coverage". This is a crime and a fraud inside of a crime and a fraud. This has left all of us with no recourse.

I feel that Procom America, LLC is continuing to exploit all of us. They are trying to sell our names, addresses, and information for money (namely \$8000.00) which if divided amongst us would be insignificant (\$3.70 per family). Given the fact that Procom America, LLC has ripped us off in an amount exceeding \$11,000,000 I think the trustee Douglas N. Menchise and the attorney, Thomas M. Wood and Special Counsel Steven M. Berman should be looking to recapture the larger sums of money that are out there, whether in the United States or overseas. Finally, what relationship does Stephen Ambrose Historical Tours have to Procom America, LLC? Is this transaction suppose to make us feel better? All of our names and addresses are listed on the internet regarding this case, so why is there a transfer of money?

These are the objections I have to this sale. This does not mean that I am giving up my rights to any monies that may come from other sources under Procom America, LLC 's bankruptcy filing.

Effective March 16, 2020, and continuing until further notice, judges in all Divisions will conduct all hearings by telephone.

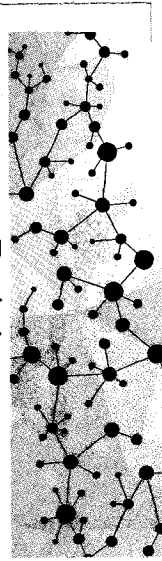

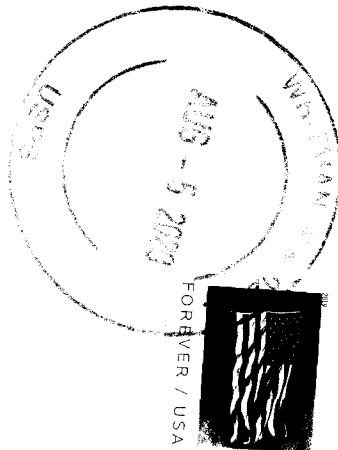
