**ORDER APPROVING APPLICATION OF CHAPTER 7 TRUSTEE,
DOUGLAS N. MENCHISE, TO EMPLOY BAKER MCKENZIE LAW FIRM
AS HUNGARIAN LOCAL COUNSEL (Doc. 398)**

THIS CASE came on for consideration without a hearing upon the Application of Chapter 7 Trustee, Douglas N. Menchise (the “Trustee”), to Employ Baker McKenzie Law Firm as Hungarian Local Counsel, (Doc. 398), pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 327 and 328 and Rules 2014 and 2016 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the “Application”). This Court has reviewed the Application and is otherwise familiar with the papers and pleadings in this case. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED:

1. The Application is **APPROVED**, as set forth herein.
2. Zoltan Hegymegi-Barakonyi, Esq., and Fehérváry Baker & McKenzie Law Firm (collectively, “Baker McKenzie”) are hereby authorized to serve as the Trustee’s Hungarian Local

Counsel for the purpose of representing the Trustee as more particularly described in the Application.

3. The Trustee shall make no payment to Baker McKenzie without first filing an Application for the allowance of such payment, and the subsequent entry of an Order approving same.

4. Further, Compensation will be determined later in accordance with 11 U.S.C. § 330.
