## ORDER GRANTING CHAPTER 7 TRUSTEE'S EMERGENCY MOTION TO COMPEL TURNOVER OF ESTATE PROPERTY

THIS CAUSE, coming on to be heard before this Court on May 19, 2020 at 10:00 a.m. on Chapter 7 Trustee's Emergency Motion to Compel Turnover of Estate Property ("Turnover Motion") [Doc 19]. In response to the Turnover Motion, the Debtor filed a Notice of Filing Detailed Listing of Communications and Associated Files Related Thereto from Renaissance Consulting & Development, LLC to Outside Parties [Doc 28]. Appearances by counsel for the parties were made on the record. Accordingly, for the reasons stated orally and recorded in open court, the Court ORDERS AND ADJUDGES as follows:

- 1. The Turnover Motion is GRANTED, in part, as set forth herein.
- 2. The Debtor, PROCOM AMERICA, LLC, stipulates and agrees to the turnover of

any of the following books and records of the Debtor to the extent such books and records are in the Debtor's possession, custody, or control:

- a. The Debtor's books and records, all customer information in its possession,
   all banking records, cancelled checks;
- b. All Quick Books information and access to Quick Books;
- c. Audited and unaudited financial statements for the Debtor;
- d. Any other financial records of PROCOM AMERICA, LLC.
- 3. The parties are in disagreement concerning the relief requested in the Turnover Motion to the extent that the motion seeks:
  - a. Providing administrative controls over the websites <u>www.bbob.com</u>;
     www.beyondbandofbrothers.com; and
  - b. Access to the Customer Relationship Management or CMR software, other than the spreadsheets containing information from the CRM software program previously provided to the Trustee.
- 4. The documents described in paragraph 2 of this Order shall be delivered through share file or drop box arrangement as agreed to by the parties.
- 5. A continued preliminary hearing on the Motion shall be held on May 27, 2020 at 10:00 a.m.
- 6. <u>Telephonic Appearance Requirement</u>. Effective March 16, 2020, and continuing until further notice, all Judges in all Divisions will conduct all hearings by telephone. For Judge Williamson, parties should arrange a telephonic appearance through Court Solutions (www.court-solutions.com). NOTE: All parties should proceed to the website and select "Sign Up." For unrepresented parties only, before submitting the completed form, you must select "I am not an

attorney" and "Certified Indigent." Once the information is submitted you will receive an email with further instructions.
