The U.S. Department of Labor ("DOL") published initial guidance last night and states that the Families First Act becomes **<u>effective on April 1, 2020</u>**, not April 2, 2020 as previously understood.

The DOL has also indicated that it will provide a 30-period of non-enforcement provided employers attempt to comply in good faith.
