- The spring [Unified Agenda](#), which by law was supposed to be released by the Biden Administration in April, was made public on July 5th and **lists the current regulatory agenda for all federal agencies**. With most of the administration's first-term regulatory initiatives already in place, the next round of big regulations from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and other agencies won't be released until after the election.
- **In response to the Supreme Court of the United States' decision regarding *Chevron* deference, House Republican Committee Chairs wrote to more than two dozen federal agencies yesterday**, including Health and Human Services, Department of Justice, EPA, Department of Labor, Department of Energy, Education, and Department of Homeland Security. Republicans want these agencies to provide a list of rules and adjudications that could be impacted by the decision if challenged and a list of pending challenges, as well as all pending rules and adjudications that could have been eligible for *Chevron* deference before the decision.
