Cheri A. Budzynski Panelist at Ohio Diversity Council's Toledo Women in Leadership Symposium

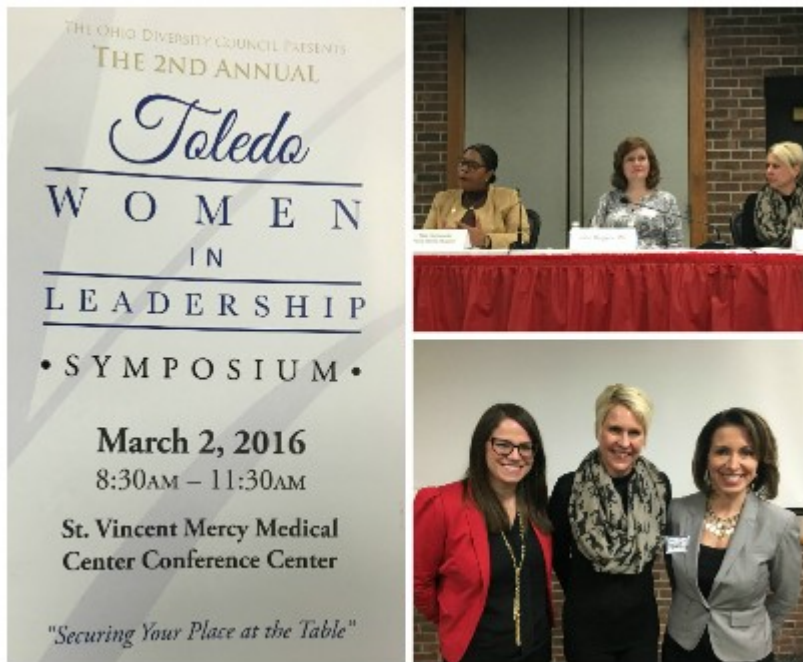
