## Indian Rocks Beach Appoints Shumaker Attorney Matthew Maggard as City Attorney

Maggard is a member of Shumaker’s Public Policy and Government Affairs, Real Estate and Development, and Litigation and Disputes service lines. He currently serves as City Attorney for the City of Zephyrhills, a Special Magistrate for Pasco County, and a Hearing Officer for Pasco County, bringing a wealth of municipal law experience to his new role.
