As the world adjusts to work-from-home, cybersecurity becomes more crucial for organizations. The Office of Civil Rights (OCR) has circulated information from the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA) at the U.S. Department of Homeland Security. The alert provides information on the top 10 Common Vulnerabilities and Exposures (CVE) relating to IT systems. These CVEs relate to a number of commonly used systems.
